





Secession of South

11 Southern states seceded from Union & formed Confederacy bcuz they wanted to retain slavery. This didn't clear conflict bcuz it lead to Civil War.

Missouri Comp

The MO Comp enforced a boundary between slave and non-slave states. ME was added as free state to balance addition MO as slave state but this was temporary.

O Dred Scott Decision

Dred Scott & family were slaves in MO when he tried to win his freedom. The court said no becuz he was free a long time b4 he went to court.

California Gold Rush

There was controversy over whether CA should be a slave state; not every1 was abolitionists but didn't think it was fair to have slaves advantage in Gold mines. Final result was a free state in Union.

Bleeding Kansas

Pro-slavery vs abolitionists in KS caused War to break out on deciding whether to be free or slave.MO helped abolitionists to win even though pro slavery people outnumbered them. This lead 2 conflict.

O John Brown's Raid

Brown was an extreme abolitionists who planned raid of Harpers Ferry to get weapons. His raid was unsuccessful bcuz it didn't help the cause but inspired others. He was hanged for rebellion.

O Caning of C. Sumner

Sumner was an abolitionist in Congress who was attacked by Brooks, nephew to Butler, in revenge for publicly bashing Butler. This was extreme ex of conflict over slavery.

Kansas Nebraska Act

This act allowed slavery to be chosen by each states legislature specifically KS and NE. These states were also created at the time. This lead to violent conflicts such as Bleeding Kansas.

Mexican American War
